COM-4: FAMILY LEARNING WEEKS

Learning together

Family learning, where children and parents engage together in learning sessions, leads to improved communication, confidence and interpersonal skills in children according to reports. Children also settled in better in class and had improved relationships with teachers and other children following the sessions. The report found that family learning can also lead to qualifications and employment for parents and give them the confidence and skills to help their child. It is recommended that family learning should be promoted as a core school activity.

Family learning programmes had a considerable impact on the achievements of both children and adults. In almost all of the providers surveyed, adults were developing good or very good skills, behaviours and parenting attitudes or were achieving success in gaining qualifications. In 16 of the providers, most adults progressed to longer courses where Skills for Life was more central to the programme. The proportion that progressed varied between providers, with fewer adults progressing when personal development targets, rather than Skills for Life qualifications, were identified as their immediate learning need. Those learners who did progress achieved high pass rates in Skills for Life qualifications. Wider benefits and progression outcomes for adults included increased involvement in school life, gaining employment, and an increased social network. The children's class teachers reported that since attending family learning, the children had settled better in class, improved relationships with their peers and teachers, and improved their communication, interpersonal skills and self-confidence.

Family Learning gives the chance to learn new skills and help child to learn in a fun and friendly way. Family Literacy and Numeracy Courses

Raising standards of literacy and numeracy for both children and parents.

Family Literacy/Numeracy

Parents can spend one day each week in their child's school. They will work with a tutor in the morning to develop new ways to help children learn. Your child will work in a small group with the class teacher. During the afternoon parents and their child will work together on fun activities. Families will be supported by the class teacher and the family learning tutor.

Early Start/Playing with Language

As above but to enhance language development and interaction between parents/carers and their babies and young children.

Family Literacy for Bilingual Families (30 hours)

These courses are designed for bilingual families and support their child's education and parents' own learning.

Family Learning Center! A place for families to Discover the Joy of Learning. At the Family Learning Center we offer private and small group tutoring, parent education classes, discussion groups, seminars, retreats, a family library, and so much more! Family Learning Center offers families and students incredible help and support, blending tutoring programs with parenting classes and seminars for parents and kids of all ages. Family learning takes place among family and friends - including mums, dads, grandparents and carers - both at home and in local communities.

It also features family activities. By doing things with your children you can help them get more from school and you can benefit from new skills, such as computer skills to having fun with cooking or kite making.

Family learning programmes and activities may include:

homework help for parents: keeping up with your 3-7 year olds

confident parenting: tips to help you help your children

anti-bullying: how to spot and deal with bullying

internet safety: how to protect your children on the net

parent support for special educational needs: extra help when needed

Kite making, playground games, badge making, healthy cookery and more

All courses are run in groups with you deciding at the beginning what parents want to achieve. As the weeks go by, parents can see how they have improved in the identified areas. At the end of the course they will be able to get advice on where you go from there.

Examples of activities to be undertaken within the project:

- partners' meetings/mobilities of learners and staff
- contact between partners and sharing experience with the use of ICT (Internet, e-mails etc., possibly videoconferences)
- development and dissemination of materials/documentation concerning training activities
- activities on the national level organized with the participation of learners
- additional activities like exhibitions/artistic works

Expected products/results:
